A very strange project for a very strange band. These punkin’ Green Bay goofs are fronted by the inimitable **Rev. Nørb**, *Maximum Rocknroll* columnist extraordinaire and all around jolly good fellow, which means this hep-cat seven-inch would probably sell big-time, even if it wasn’t a fabulous rocknroll single, even if it wasn’t pressed in SIX DIFFERENT COLORS of vinyl, even if it didn’t slag off on the punk rock whipping boys of the hour, Green Day. An all new version of the lead track off the Boris debut album, an oi classic dealing with, um, well, drugs and masturbation. (Hey, if Billie Joe can make a bazillion bucks off of those topics, the least you can do is help The Rev. cash in!). Boris the Sprinkler is a classic goof-punk band in the vein of such greats as THE WEIRDOS, THE REZILLOS, and THE TOY DOLLS. The flip-side is a non-album cover of an intellectually-stimulating classic, “Yeah Yeah,” a swell song by The Revillos copped from The Rockateens.

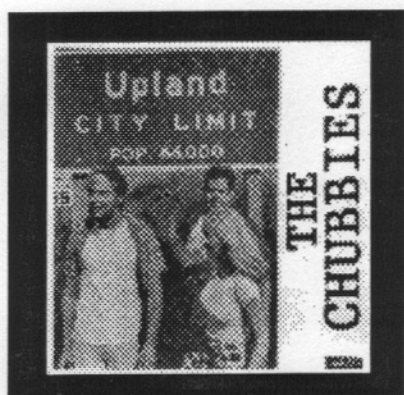
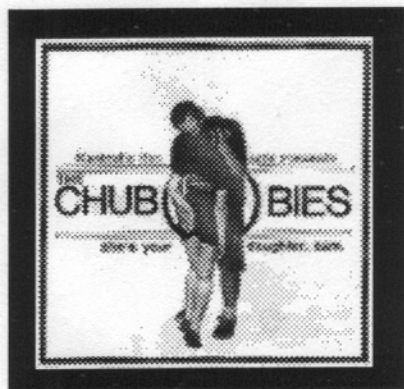
THE CHUBBIES — "She's Your Daughter, Sam" 7" EP
