There's also a SCHLEPROCK EP available from 1000FL. When you add that to the gob of stuff you can get from Mordam, you'll be there.


### EXPLODING WHITE MICE— We Walk Alone CD LUCKY RECORDS LK-12 \$7.25 now available


These guys are gonna take over the world some day. Be there or be square. Fab pink vinyl (opaque bubblegum or clear fuschia), too!




