Alloooo! Time to rock and roll out another installment of the good ol' Mutant Pop catalog. Get ready...

First off, the new **MP-25 THE AUTOMATICS "Karaoke Party"** record has finally hit the street... The huge pile of preorders is now out the door, if you don't have it yet, you'd better hustle your bustle! "Karaoke Party" is gonna be limited to 1050 copies, of which the band gets 150. That leaves 900 for preorders, distributors, mailorder, and export. No reissuing, when the one and only pressing is gone, this title will be out of print! It's a big planet and a popular band, the 900 copies should move pretty fast...

This record is a weird one, incorporating a couple strange ideas that I had over the years. First off, every single record is white with a plain red label. Not only does this mean that it looks like a Japanese flag (yaay, Japan!) but you can't tell which side is the A side (with vocals) and which is the B side (singalong). Ho ho ho, have fun! Two versions each of three great tunes, including "Tokyo"—a classic Jesse S. pop hit if I've ever heard one—and "Pure and Beautiful Love," a totally goofy SEWER TROUT cover. There's also a non-album cover of a non-album RAMONES song called "I Don't Wanna Be Learned, I Don't Wanna Be Tamed." The sleeve is another tip of the hat to our friends from the Far East, a Japanese-style picture insert rather than a proper foldover pic sleeve.

Yep, yep, yep, this one came out pretty dang cool. I'm very happy! It looks nice, it sounds great, and I think it will turn out to be a swell little collectors' item in a couple of years... Three bucks and damned well worth it!!!



Speaking of happy, I am completely delighted to announce that **MP-506 THE AUTOMATICS Go Bananas!** is now rocketing towards completion. This full-length was recorded way back in June, it's a long time in coming! The cover is a piss-take on the first punk rock album ever produced, the 1976 DAMNED debut, *Damned Damned Damned*. We're also gonna be spending \$500 to do a big, full-color promotional poster—which will itself be a parody of the original DAMNED promo poster. This project scores so many coolness points that it's off the fucking chart. Never mind that the album features 20 killer AUTOMATICS songs, a great many of which have previously never been released and are exclusive to this project. A very nice production job, too, if I do say so myself—clean sounding but not overpolished. The band's patented buzzsaw guitar and deep harmonies are in force and the debate is on as to whether this album is better than the band's mind-numbingly amazing self-titled debut. The price is \$10 and yes, preorders are not only welcome, they are very helpful. This baby should be on the street in March and it's gonna attract a lot of favorable attention!



Posters will be available when they're ready—the band's and my goal is to land a copy in the hands of every single AUTOMATICS fan who wants one. Who cares about shifting units by blanketing stores, we want your bedroom wall!!!

And we also won't forget the new **MP-29 CLETUS "More Songs About Other People's Girlfriends"** record... The band's new album on Johann's Face Records is totally killer and this wonderful slab of amazing turquoise vinyl is two notches above terrific, too. Four great songs from the QUEERS 1234 punk food group that we all adore... Funny and catchy and snotty and it rocks like a momma bear. Don't let this one get lost amidst the AUTOMATICS hoopla, because you'll be one sorry puppy if you don't snarf up a colored copy while you can. The hits come spewing out one after the other, my personal fave is "Amy Left Me for Some Emo Guy"—with Johnny Puke's trademark bitter lyrics and sneer married to one of the catchiest rockers you'll ever hear. Two thumbs up. Toss three more chips onto the table...

Oh, dear, silly me, I forgot to mention that I also have the brand new **MP-28 BORIS THE SPRINKLER "(She Digs My) New Wave Records"** single shipping, too. Other labels might settle for non-album throwaways, Mutant Pop wants *hits*!!! So I once again picked my favorite track from the most recent Boris album and had the band remake the



song for M-Pop. Again, Rev. Nørb and the Green Bay goofs have surpassed themselves—the MP single version of “New Wave Records” dusts the version on *Mega Anal*. We thought it would be a nice touch if the band covered “Yellow Pills” by 20-20 on the flip, since the lyrics to “New Wave Records” mention the song, while no more than a handful of people under age 30 have ever heard it. Not only that, the band added another New Wave cover song for good measure, “Hi, We’re the Replacements” by THEY MIGHT BE GIANTS. So for three piddly bucks you get two non-album tracks plus a smoking new version of a smoking BORIS original. First 500 on opaque yellow-pill-colored vinyl, you bet. Those colored copies are gonna fucking fly, so get your order in *fast!!!* Oh, did I mention: this release features a full color picture sleeve as well, with a complete Boris discography that Nørb and I compiled inside? Do you need it??? I think so! Shit, you’ve just spent your first twenty bills and you aren’t even to other labels’ stuff yet...



Time to take out a loan, eh?

Anyhow, I really appreciate the support that members of the Mutant Pop Cult have given this label. There is no way possible that I could be cranking out the killer stuff like this without the unflagging support of hundreds of fellow pop-punk freaks from around the world. When you buy crap from Mutant Pop, the proceeds wind up being churned back into studio time and printers’ film and mastering and record pressing, and even more cool crap is the eventual result. I know it sounds corny, but I just wanted to let you know that I really do appreciate your dedication, kind words, and financial support.

BORIS THE SPRINKLER “113o Uomo” IMPORT \$4

Here’s one fresh out of the oven from Italy. The title track is called “113th Man,” so now you know a little Italian... A great little record in a full color sleeve. Two different colors of vinyl, you fanatical Nørb fans can just send me **\$7 for both colors**, while supplies last. Another solid effort from one of the most important contemporary punk bands. Get that BORIS collection going!!!



THE NUTLEY BRASS “Ramones Songbook v. 2” \$3

The stupidity continues! Easy listening muzak versions of three of your RAMONES favorites from the inimitable NUTLEY BRASS. Sounds like the soundtrack from an ultra-cheesy early 1960s movie, ’cept the songs are “Blitzkrieg Bop,” “Teenage Lobotomy,” and “Something to Believe In.” Very funny shit here. At least some copies on limited blue vinyl, grab fast!!!

SEVEN TEEN YEARS “Please Stop That” \$3

Totally great stuff, a *countrified* punk’n’roll flavor, and I mean that in the very best sense of the term. Vein of DR. BOB’S NIGHTMARE or something—big hooks and boy/girl harmonies...

“Dirty Old Town” is a certifiable pop hit, the B-side rocks, too. Ya gotta admire They Still Make Records for having the hair to put this one out... If you’re burning out on the same old shit, try this for a change of pace...



BEATNIK TERMITES “Lineage” \$3

Everybody loves the BEATNIK TERMITES. Two covers here, “Suburban Home” by THE DESCENDENTS and “Minute” by ALL. Or is it the other way around? Dunno, I skipped both of those bands. But I’m not skipping Cleveland’s finest, BEATNIK TERMITES are one of the most distinctive and best pop-punk bands of the 1990s, as their legions of fans will agree. This includes a box of crayons so you can customize your own PS!



PINKY split w/ THE MIXELPRICKS \$3

In every one of these catalogs I try and give a huge push to an obscure pop-punk gem, a top quality EP on a little label that would disappear unseen and unheard in the Land of the Vinyl Glut without a little action on my part.
